Alumni Interview

Dr. Banwari khatik
Physiotherapy (2018-2022)



Question : We're thrilled to have you here to share your experiences . Could you start by telling us a bit about yourself and your journey since you graduated?

It's great to be back. My name is **Dr. Banwari khatik** , and I graduated from **Jagannath University in 2022** . After completing my degree in Physiotherapy, I joined **shree balaji Neuro rehabilitation centre , Bhilwara Rajasthan.** ,where I have been working as a **chief physiotherapist**. Over the past few years, I've had the opportunity to work with a diverse range of patients and conditions, which has been incredibly rewarding.

Question: That sounds fantastic! What inspired you to choose a career in physiotherapy?

I've always been passionate about helping others and promoting physical health. During my high school years, I was actively involved in sports and witnessed firsthand the impact that injuries can have on athletes. This picked my interest in physiotherapy as a way to help people recover and regain their mobility. The ability to make a tangible difference in someone's quality of life is truely motivated me.

Question: What is one of the most rewarding aspects of being a physiotherapist?

One of the most rewarding aspects is seeing the progress in my patients. When someone comes in with severe pain or limited mobility and, over time, they're able to return to activities they love—whether it's playing sports, walking without a limp, or just feeling more energetic—that's incredibly fulfilling. Helping people regain independence and improve their quality of life is what motivates me every day.

Question: For someone considering a career in physiotherapy, what advice would you give ?

First and foremost, I'd say be prepared for continuous learning. Physiotherapy is a dynamic field that evolves quickly, so staying up-to-date with the latest research and treatment techniques is essential. You also need to have strong interpersonal skills. You'll be working closely with people in pain or recovery, so patience, empathy, and clear communication are key to building trust and getting results. And lastly, be patient with your own development. It takes time to become proficient in all the skills you need, so focus on gradually building your expertise and experience.

Interviewer: Thank you so much for your insights. It's been a pleasure learning more about your work and the field of physiotherapy.

To be true I never thought of becoming a Lawyer, however the legal profession always fascinated me. As a Lawyer, I am graceful that with the help of legal knowledge and its offerings, we are able to give our clients advice and assist them to resolve the legal issues. Further it also helps with arbitration and other ADR mechanism; we attend the legal matters outside the courtroom realm and get the issues settled amicably among the parties. Lawyers are in a unique position to support people, groups, and organizations with their legal issues and to further the public good. We can say that lawyers are the traditional mass mouthpiece at the law court.

During my internship in Bombay in my 5year Law course at Ahmadabad, I got to know that the Lawyers in Bombay used to charge good fee per Hearing which will come to around Rs. 2 Lac to 5 Lacs per Case (Sometimes even 10 Lacs) for the entire case depending on the lawyer. Less than 50K is rare at Bombay High Court level mainly. Considering the starting perks in practising, I started practising Law at Bombay High Court and joined the Office of my College senior at Bombay. I had a notion in initial days of my practise in Mumbai that all lawyers make a lot of money, although that may be true provided you should have good knowledge and liaison skills. Now, I have started my independent practise in Bombay and making approx. 1 lacs in a month.

I would like to say that it is very pertinent to know before starting your professional career: How many hours would you like to work each week? How much money would you like to make? With practising law, I learned discipline in life interalia starting the day with bowing to the Hon'ble judges immediately after entering the courtroom and bow while leaving the court and then exit and also listening and observing the proceedings in the court room without making any noise.

Before step into practising law, you ask themselves certain questions to ensure that how you align your career goals in life and whether you are ready to give your time in reading books and marketing your skills. Subsequently, we have to nurture our beliefs in achieving professional goals with the conscience what type of individuals would you like to serve? How you are helping society for common good. 


